Your FAQ's: Answered!

Straight talk to get you started.

What is it?!

Scrip is substitute money: ordinary gift cards that are just like what you would purchase directly at a restaurant, clothing store or grocery store. It's the same as you would send in a birthday card. The difference is that the scrip center sells them to our group at a discount, thus providing the fundraising dollars to our school. The cards are delivered to you to use like cash when you shop.

What do I do?

Go online to www.ShopWithScrip.com and create a free account. Click on “Create Account” in the green Family Sign Up box. For St. Rita's enrollment code send an email to stephrosales@comcast.net. Then browse through the available choices of cards by category, alphabetically or by search.

When do I order?

You can place your order online any time that is convenient for you. Once your payment is made, your order is consolidated with all the other St. Rita family orders and is submitted on **Tuesday at noon**. The cards are delivered to the school, separated per family and then available to you by Friday afternoon pick-up.

How do I pay?

You can pay by **check made out to St. Rita School** or pay online using the secure ACH process called PrestoPay. If you pay by check, send it into school no later than Monday to my attention through Claire Rosales, 7th grade, OR, hand it to me in the Tuesday morning drop-off line. (I'm the lady waving with the Scrip sign in the parking lot.) If you'd like the convenience of paying online just click the PrestoPay link and be sure to allow yourself about a week for that to be set up to debit your checking account.

When will I get my Scrip?

Scrip orders will be delivered at Friday afternoon's pick-up, or you can elect to have yours sent home in your child's school folder (backpack mail).

What kinds of Scrip are available for purchase?

Go to the school's Scrip page on the PTO section or to ShopWithScrip.com for a complete list of the hundreds of well known retailers available.

Why bother?

Get into the habit! The power of Scrip is in the group. Every household's normal spending adds up to tens of thousands of dollars annually. If everyone in the school funnels some of their normal purchases through our scrip program then those retailer contribution percentages really add up...over \$6000 to date! This is free money to our school, with no selling on the part of the parents! The potential is thousands of dollars to spend for the benefit of our children.
